Additional information:

For Danish applicants, the rules of GUDP prevail, but the international application- and budget templates have to be used; only in case of granted funding, a budget scheme including a Gantt chart for the Danish part of the work, and participant datasheets have to be submitted.

Applications for funding can be submitted by:

- Large, medium and small size enterprises (incl. other stakeholders such as independent institutions, private research organizations, and owners, tenants and users of farms)
- Research and other public knowledge institutes
- Technical Service Institutes (GTS) – are classified as companies
- Non-profit organizations

Funding from GUDP cannot be granted directly to foreign institutions or businesses registered outside of Denmark. However, those may participate as an external consultant to a Danish applicant.
